• 44TH STREET EMPLOYEE CIRCULATOR

- Circulator service is available 24/7 and from Phoenix Sky Train® to the 44th Street Employee Parking Lot
- Circulators run every 10 minutes

• PHX SKY TRAIN® OPERATIONS

- PHX Sky Train® runs every 3-6 minutes
- Heavy maintenance is performed on Tuesdays and Saturdays from 12:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m. During this time, a single train is operated between the 44th Street and the East Economy Stations. A separate single train is operated between the East Economy and the Terminal Stations. Passengers traveling to/from the Terminal Stations to/from the 44th Street Station will need to change trains at the East Economy Station.
